You have been identified as being located within a designated disaster zone and having Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS Office), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), and/or Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) awards.

If you have not yet submitted your quarterly financial and regular performance reports (due October 30, 2024), DOJ will apply a 90-day extension in JustGrants to those deadlines. The new deadline will be January 30, 2025.

If the impact of Hurricanes Milton and Helene is also causing hardship affecting your ability to meet application deadlines, meet specific award deliverables or timelines, or close out awards, please reach out to your DOJ Grant Manager. Further flexibilities will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
